3.1 ENGAGE WITH FIRST NATIONS TO BETTER UNDERSTAND THEIR VALUES AND THEIR EXPERIENCE WITH WILDFIRE IN THE PROJECT AREA

DISCUSSION: BC Parks recognizes the importance of First Nation interests in the area of Wells Gray Park. It is integral to the Wells Gray WRMP process to engage with First Nations to determine both threat and opportunity to values within the project area.

ACTIONS:

1. Engage in conversations with First Nations to better understand and determine their values at risk in Wells Gray Park, communication protocols, and best management practices for wildfire in the traditional territory of First Nation groups.
